Community Partnership: PAVE

At Goodwill, we believe in the Power of the Whole community working together to provide a "hand up" to support individuals with emergency needs in trying times.



We partner with <u>Protect Advocate Validate Educate</u> (PAVE) to help empower people affected by violence in Dodge and Jefferson Counties. Through our Goodwill Cares Community Assistance program, we provide vouchers to PAVE to distribute to people in the community for the purchase of clothing and household items at a Goodwill Store & Donation Center. Our partnership with PAVE helped a single mother with two children leave one of its shelters with clothes and shoes for her children. Goodwill Cares vouchers were also provided to the mother to help furnish her home: "I was able to decorate my new apartment for myself and kids and make it feel like a home. I am so grateful for this opportunity that Goodwill and PAVE gave me to start over in a violence-free environment. Thank you."
